New Business

- A. The Council reviewed a resolution to investigate sufficiency for the voluntary annexation of 2636 and 2640 Clarks Chapel Road, Lenoir, NC 28645. The Council voted unanimously to pass the resolution.
- B. The Council discussed adopting a junked and abandoned motor vehicle ordinance and a tall grass ordinance. Citizens spoke on the matter, saying they desire the Town to adopt ordinances that govern both. The Council instructed the manager to draft a proposal for both of the aforementioned ordinances.
- C. The Council reviewed a proposal from ActionSign for two entrance signs into the Town. Councilman Robbins asked the manager to compile several more proposals before making a final decision.
- D. A representative from Promises of Hope asked the Council to donate \$300 to the program. The program seeks to provide support to those who help underprivileged children in Caldwell County. The Council voted unanimously to approve the donation.
