New Business

- A. The Council reviewed voluntary annexation requests from 2545 Timberwood Drive and 2567 Timberwood Drive. The Council approved, on motion by Mayor Pro Tem Stewart and second by Councilman Robbins, a resolution directing the Town Manager to investigate the sufficiency for annexation of both properties.
- B. The Council conducted a hearing for two junked motor vehicle violations at 731 Pleasant Hill Rd., Lenoir, NC 28645. The Council voted, on motion by Mayor Pro Tem Stewart and second by Councilman Bolick, to allow the resident owners 30 days to get into compliance with the Town's Ordinance. If they did not, a fee of \$50 per day would go into effect 30 days after receiving the notification letter. Then if they accumulate \$500 in fees, the Town would stop fining the property owner and remove the two vehicles. The Council approved with Councilman Robbins in disagreement of the motion.
