The Town Council of the Town of Cahaj's Mountain met at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 6th, 2017, in the Meeting Room of the Cahaj's Mountain Town Hall, 1800 Connelly Springs Road, Lenoir, NC 28645.

Call to Order & Welcome

Mayor Ronnie Setzer called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.

Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance

Councilman Robbins gave the invocation, which was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Adoption of the Agenda

The agenda was unanimously approved on motion by Mayor Pro Tem Stewart and seconded by Councilman Bolick.

Approval of the Minutes

Mayor Pro Tem Stewart motioned to approve the minutes from April 4th, 2017, seconded by Councilman Bolick.

New Business

- A. Town Manager Shook opened up discussions about possible traffic solutions to the intersection of Red Oak Drive and Timber Ridge Drive. Mayor Pro Tem Stewart presented issues with the intersection to the Council. He suggested a possible 4-way stop to reduce speed of vehicles coming through the intersection. The rest of the Council agreed, and the notion of lane dividers was also brought up to keep all drivers on the correct side of their driving lane. The Council voted unanimously to petition the NCDOT to make the intersection a 4-way stop with lane dividers.
- B. Town Manager Shook presented the Council with a DOT speed limit reduction request inside of Oakmont Drive. The request reduced the speed limit from 35mph to 25mph. The Council approved the change unanimously.
- C. Town Manager Shook presented the second reading of the 2017-2018 fiscal year budget before the Council. Councilman Robbins motioned to approve the 2017-2018 Budget Ordinance with a second from Mayor Pro Tem Stewart. Mayor Setzer then opened a **public hearing** for all parties to comment on the budget. There was not input from the public. Mayor Setzer then closed the public hearing and asked for a vote on the ordinance. The Council approved the 2017-2018 Budget Ordinance unanimously.
- D. Town Manager Shook presented the Council with the North Carolina Statewide Emergency Management Mutual Aid and Assistance Agreement. The agreement, after being reviewed, was approved unanimously by the Council.

Mayor Setzer informed the Council he and Town Manager Shook met with Clarence Lockamy of the Wooten Company to discuss sewer expansion. The discussions revolved around expansion in two areas: Clarks Chapel Rd and Bradshaw Terrace. The Mayor stated that Wooten
